Requirements:

- **Parents have to live within our boundaries or be active registered members of our Parish for a minimum of 6 months.**
- Child must be 6 years or younger.
- Godparents are required to have *all* their sacraments, including marriage if it applies to them.
- Both Parents and Godparents need to attend the Pre-Baptismal class that is held on January 29th , 6pm-9pm.

Call into our parish office to register by **January 27th**. There is a \$50 registration fee, and we will need a photocopy of the child's birth certificate.

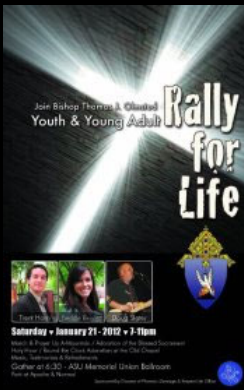
