

Seventh Sunday of Easter

This Seventh Sunday of Easter is a time of waiting, just as Jesus at his Ascension had promised the coming of the Spirit, but had asked them to wait patiently. As we wait, we are presented with visions of the future promised by God. In the Gospel, Jesus expresses his deep longing for all of God's beloved to be in unity with God. The passage from Revelation concludes the Bible, envisioning the completion of God's mission to heal and reconcile with us. And in Acts, Stephen's vision of Jesus at God's side points to the centrality of Jesus to make this come about. We continue Jesus' ministry by healing and forgiving as he did; by rejecting violence or seeking power over others; and by enduring suffering when necessary. This time of waiting echoes the hope and anticipation we experience in all of life, as we await the final fulfillment of God's promised future.

GOD'S PROMISES

We hear today from the conclusion of the Bible's final book, in Revelation 22. John of Patmos uses imagery to summarize the messages of his book: that God has been faithful to humanity and to the chosen followers, even when they have not. God acts justly in dealing with us, and also acts graciously in forgiveness. God is trustworthy, promising a future beyond our greatest dreams, and working continuously toward its realization. Jesus is revealed to be at the center of all God's saving work. Through all the imagery presented in John's visions, the author wants his readers to make a choice. In his environment, he asked for a choice between the idol of the Roman imperial system, or of God revealed in Jesus. In our own time, each culture, always a mix of virtue or of sin, has elements of idolatry that make false promises. When we encounter these idols, do we fully trust God and God's promises? Whom do we serve?

Séptimo Domingo de Pascua

Este séptimo domingo de Pascua es un tiempo de espera, como Jesús en su Ascensión había prometido la venida del Espíritu, pero les había pedido que esperaran con paciencia. Mientras esperamos, se nos presentan visiones del futuro prometido por Dios. En el Evangelio, Jesús expresa su profundo anhelo de que todos los amados de Dios estén en unidad con él. El pasaje del Apocalipsis concluye la Biblia, previendo la culminación de la misión de Dios de sanar y reconciliarse con nosotros. Y en los Hechos, la visión de Esteban de Jesús al lado de Dios señala la centralidad de Jesús para que esto ocurra. Continuamos el ministerio de Jesús curando y perdonando como él lo hizo; rechazando la violencia o la búsqueda de poder sobre los demás; y soportando el sufrimiento cuando sea necesario.

Este tiempo de espera se hace eco de la esperanza y la anticipación que experimentamos en toda la vida, mientras esperamos el cumplimiento final del futuro prometido por Dios.

LAS PROMESAS DE DIOS

Hoy escuchamos la conclusión del último libro de la Biblia, en el Apocalipsis 22. Juan de Patmos utiliza imágenes para resumir los mensajes de su libro: que Dios ha sido fiel a la humanidad y a los seguidores elegidos, incluso cuando ellos no lo han sido. Dios actúa con justicia al tratar con nosotros, y también actúa con gracia al perdonarnos. Dios es digno de confianza, prometiendo un futuro más allá de nuestros mayores sueños, y trabajando continuamente para su realización. Jesús se revela como el centro de toda la obra salvadora de Dios. A través de todas las imágenes presentadas en las visiones de Juan, el autor quiere que sus lectores hagan una elección. En su entorno, pide que se elija entre el ídolo del sistema imperial romano o el Dios revelado en Jesús. En nuestro propio tiempo, cada cultura, siempre una mezcla de virtud o de pecado, tiene elementos de idolatría que hacen falsas promesas. Cuando nos encontramos con estos ídolos, ¿confiamos plenamente en Dios y en sus promesas? ¿A quién servimos?
